The first 39 - OT the last 27 - NT. That is why there is such a different "style." It is not that there is a different author, it is that God has written for us a perfect book that is on a level super human.

So what about that section they call the "little apocalypse?" Those are chapters 24-27.

They would correspond to Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel. These are prophetic books that spoke heavily of the suffering of the Babylonian Captivity - no doubt a mini apocalypse. So even the Bible critics have further proved our case for the book of Isaiah.

I know it sounds impossible, but the book of Isaiah perfectly coordinates each chapter with the corresponding book of the Bible. Isaiah, written centuries before and after other scriptures, has to be a _____ book in order to accomplish that.

GENERAL INTRODUCTION TO ISAIAH

The time period and authorship of Isaiah are given in the first verse of the book, **Isaiah 1:1**

The author of the book of Isaiah was _____ himself.

While the authorship of Isaiah has been under attack in recent years, the Scriptures are 100% in agreement that the book was written by Isaiah - and only ONE Isaiah!

Critics of the Bible try to disprove Isaiah's authorship with two main arguments:

First, because there are "_____" and "_____" changes in the different sections of Isaiah. Particularly, two main sections of Isaiah.

Second - "Impossible _____ Statements"

Example - Persian King Cyrus was prophesied by Isaiah _____ years before he was _____. This is the definition of prophecy, and we believe God "inspired these words!"

Reasons for the Differing "Styles"

The book of Isaiah contains _____ chapters, with some clear divisions and sections.

The Scriptures themselves, as well as textual tools and experts agree that Isaiah was the sole author of the book. There are not two authors, there is nothing to debate. Jesus, John the Baptist, and Paul all quoted Isaiah's "different" sections and credited authorship to Isaiah every time.

The divisions of Isaiah are as follows: 66 chapters total, 39 having one style and 27 having another style.

Warren Wiersbe correctly identifies the style difference in his outline where he divides the first portion from the latter this way:

Ch 1-39 - The Sin and Condemnation of Israel and the Gentiles
Ch 40-66 - The Consolation of God Toward His People

Even the Jewish _____ refer to the last 27 chapters as the book of Consolation.

What is going on here?

Well, your Bible has 66 books. 39 Old Testament, 27 New Testament.

The first 39 books of the Bible deal with Israel and Humanity in view of the law of God - we call this the dispensation of the law.

The last 27 book of the Bible, the New Testament deals with God's grace toward man - we call this the dispensation of Grace!

Robert T Boyd identifies the division of Isaiah as:

Ch 1-39 - Indictment against Israel for Sin and need of repentance.

Ch 40-66 - God's redemption through the coming Messiah and His Future Kingdom

The division of "styles" perfectly describes the _____ change from Old to New Testament.
