2 Corinthians 6:14-18

If we fail to drive out all the “giants” in our lives, we will fall into the same pattern as Israel did.

Sin → Suffering → Supplication → Deliverance

Colossians 3:5-6 KJV - "*Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience.*"

Romans 6:6 KJV - "*Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.*"

Matthew 18:8-9 KJV - "*Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast them from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire. And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.*"
